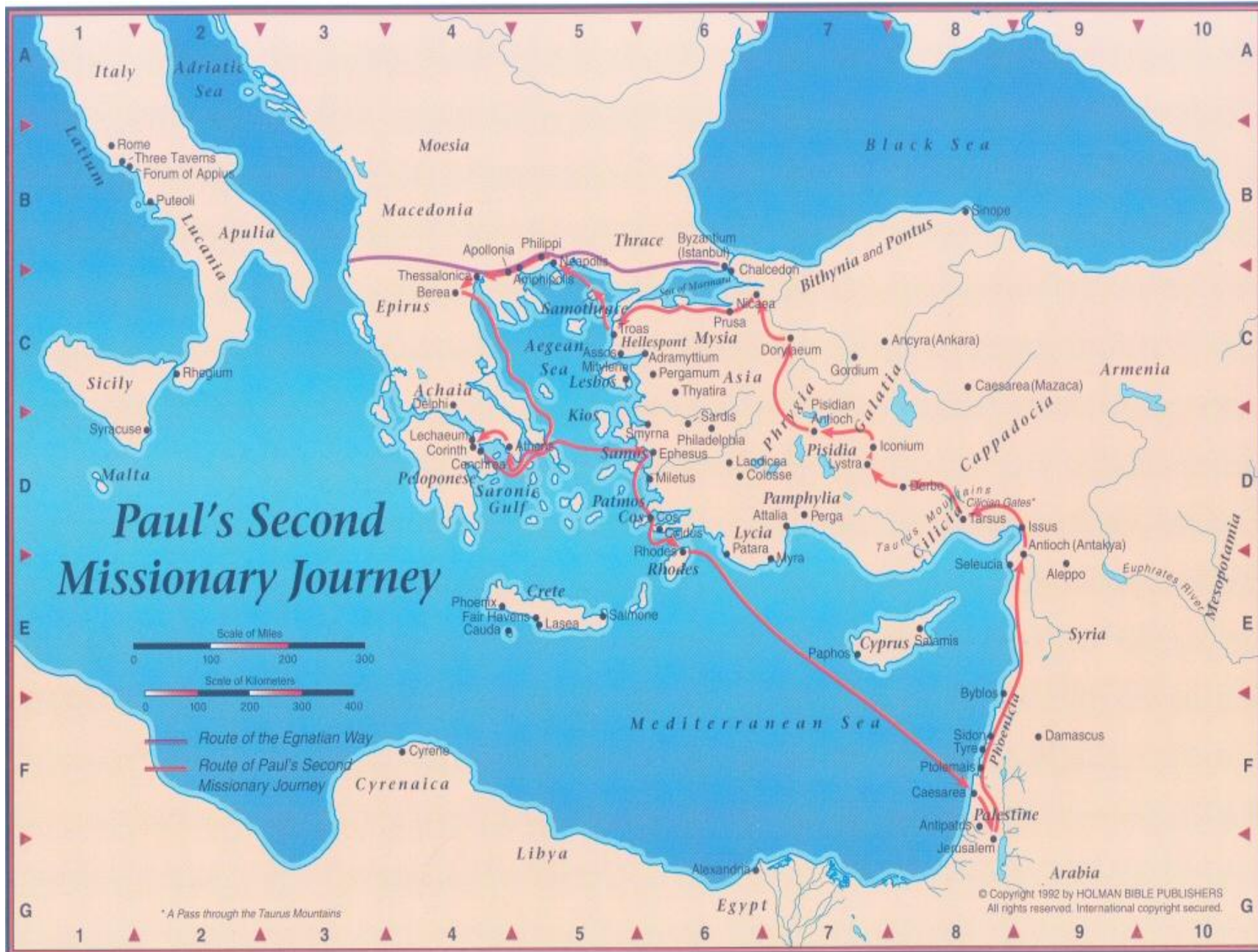


- 4. **Sin**—two wills, Gods & yours; remember this, everytime you sin—you are imposing your will over God's will & the result is **sin**
- 5. **Faith**—faith in it's final analysis is us submitting our will to God's will...for Salvation; Spirituality; living Spirit filled life; we are saying to God, **not my will**, but thine—When we walk by faith we are saying it is your will, not mine!

- who have been sanctified in Christ Jesus,
- saints by calling,
- with all who in every place
- call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- their Lord and ours:

- **Called:** Whosoever: All are called;
- God is not willing that any should die
- **The Call:**
 - the cross
 - called by the gospel
 - called to faith in Jesus Christ
 - called out of the kosmos &
 - called into the Kingdom of God

- Heb.10:24 and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love & good deeds, encourage to walk by faith
- 25 not forsaking our own assembling together as is the habit of some, but encouraging One Another; & all the more, as you see the day drawing near.

- 1 Pet. 1:16 because it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy"
- Matt.5:48 Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.
- How?

- 1 Cor. 9:13 Do you not know that those who perform sacred services eat the food of the temple, & those who attend regularly to the altar have their share with the altar?
- **Heiros**
- 1 Cor. 6:11 & such **thieves, covetous, drunkards, revilers, swindlers** were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of /the Lord Jesus Christ, & in the Spirit of our God.

- Three categories or phases of sanctification
- **a. Positional Sanctification** –Phase 1 or Sal. 1
- we are positioned in JC 1 Cor. 1:2, 30; 6:11; Heb. 10:10 & 14; & 13:12; 2 Thes. 2:13; Col. 2:10
- **b. Experiential Sanctification** Phase 2 or Sal. 2
F/HS GJ 17:17; Eph. 5:26; 2 Pet. 3:18; 1 Thes. 4:3; 5:23; 2 Thes. 2:13; 1 Pet. 1:2
- **c. Ultimate Sanctification** Phase 3—Set apart to God for all eternity. Resurrected Body w/o sin nature Col. 3:4; 1 Cor. 15:53; 1 Thes. 5:23 & 25b. Phil. 3:21; 1 Jn 3:1-2;

- We are *shot*: instrument/means---gun—that is Jesus Christ: instrument of our Sanctification.
- Agent: Holy Spirit
- Ultimate source: Will of God
- Result: Sanctified in Christ
- Our part: simple faith in Jesus Christ
