

- 1 Pet. 1:16 because it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy"
- Matt.5:48 Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.
- 1 Cor. 9:13 Do you not know that those who perform sacred services eat the food of the temple, & those who attend regularly to the altar have their share with the altar? Heiros

- “It is not moral action on the part of man, but a divinely effected state”
- 1 Cor. 6:11 & such thieves, covetous, drunkards, revilers, swindlers were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, & in the Spirit of our God.

- Three categories or phases of sanctification
- **a. Positional Sanctification** –Phase 1 or Sal. 1
- we are positioned in JC 1 Cor. 1:2, 30; 6:11; Heb. 10:10 & 14; & 13:12; 2 Thes. 2:13; Col. 2:10
- **b. Experiential Sanctification** Phase 2 or Sal. 2
F/HS GJ 17:17; Eph. 5:26; 2 Pet. 3:18; 1 Thes. 4:3; 5:23; 2 Thes. 2:13; 1 Pet. 1:2
- **c. Ultimate Sanctification** Phase 3—Set apart to God for all eternity. Resurrected Body w/o sin nature Col. 3:4; 1 Cor. 15:53; 1 Thes. 5:23 & 25b. Phil. 3:21; 1 Jn 3:1-2;

- Rom. 15:16 to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles, ministering as a priest the gospel of God, that my offering of the Gentiles might become acceptable,
sanctified by /Holy Spirit.
- Acts 26:18 to open their eyes Satan seeks to **blind our eyes** so that they may turn from darkness to light & from the dominion of Satan to God, **we have studied how history of man is history of two kingdoms *tale of two Kingdoms*** in order that they may receive forgiveness of sins & an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

- 2 Thes. 2:13 But we should always give thanks to God for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth.
- Heb.10:10 By this will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.
- v 14 For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.

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- We are *shot*: **instrument/means---gun**—
that is Jesus Christ: instrument of our
Sanctification.
- **Agent:** Holy Spirit
- **Ultimate source:** Will of God
- **Result:** Sanctified in Christ
- Our part: simple faith in Jesus Christ

- 1 Cor. 6:11 & such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ,
- and in the Spirit of our God.
- this time we have prep. *en* instrumental by means of HS

- Who sanctified us? God Holy Spirit
- By what did He sanctified us? Work of Jesus Christ
- By whose authority or will did He Sanctify us? God the Father
- & what was our part? By faith

- 5. Mechanics of Sanctification 1 Cor. 15:51-57
- 1. **Positional** –by Baptism of HS 1 Cor. 12:13
- 2, **Experiential** –grace recovery by faith in Holy Spirit - walk in light Eph. 5:8-10;
- 3. **Ultimate** – 3 fold:
 - a. **body**—blameless 1 Thes. 5:23; Phil. 3:21;
1 J 3:1-2
 - b. **Soul** –blameless 1 Thes. 5:23; Heb. 10:39;
 - c. **Spirit** – blameless 1 Thes. 5:23; 1 Cor. 1:8

- A. doctrine of Positional Truth
 - 1. PT is not an experience or emotion
 - 2. PT is not progressive –cannot be improved
 - 3. PT is not related to human merit or performance
 - 4. it is eternal in nature
 - 5. It is known only by revelation of Word of God by Holy Spirit
 - 6. It is obtained by Grace at moment of Faith in Jesus Christ

- Doctrine of the Baptism of Holy Spirit
- 1. did not occur in OT
- 2. 1st prophesied by Christ GJ 14:20
- 3. basis of unification of all bel.s Eph. 4:5
- 4. because of Baptism of Holy Spirit: no racial, social or sexual distinctions in body of Christ Gal. 3:26-28
- 5. It is basis of victory over sin in Holy Spirit Rom. 6;3-4
- 6. It began the Church-Age Acts 1:5 & 11:15.
- 7. It is the means of Sanctification Eph. 1:3-6
- 8. It is not experiential...no feeling, or emo.

- 2 Thes. 2:13 But we should always give thanks to God **prayer** for you, **for OA brethren we are related to every bel. in Jesus Christ** beloved by the Lord, **every bel. is loved by JC** because God has chosen you from the beginning **chosen those who respond to the called** --for salvation-- through sanctification-- by Spirit and faith in the truth. **Gospel for unbel. & bel)**
- 14 And it was for **this** He called you through our gospel, **that -in order** that you may gain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- NASV saints by calling
- KJ called to be saints
- NIV called to be holy

- 2 Tim. 1:9 who **God the Father** has saved us, & called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose & according to grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity,
- Gal. 1:6 I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him **God the Father** who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel;
- Rom. 8:30 & whom He **God the Father** predestined, these He also called; & whom He called, these He also justified; & whom He justified, these He also glorified.

- 1 Cor. 1:9 God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
- 2 Thess. 2:14 & it was for this He called you through our gospel, that you may gain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Rom. 10:14 How then shall they call upon Him in whom they have not believed? & how shall they believe in Him whom they have not heard? & how shall they hear without a preacher?

- Acts 13:2 & while they were ministering to the Lord & fasting, **the Holy Spirit said**, "Set apart for Me Barnabas & Saul for the work to which **I** have called them."
- Rom. 1:6 among whom you also are the called of Jesus Christ;
- 1 Tim. 6: 12 Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called, and you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

- 1 Pet. 5:10 & after you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen and establish you.
- Col. 1:15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful.

- 1 Pet. 2:20 For what credit is there if, when you sin and are harshly treated, you endure it with patience? But if when you do what is right & suffer for it you patiently endure it, this finds favor with God.
- 21 For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps,
- Phil. 1:29 For to you it has been granted for Christ's sake, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake,
