- Schisms
- 1. Bible does not condone schisms or divisions in local-Church.
- 2. However the Bible does condone & encourage separation.
- 3. The distinction in these two words: schisms & separation is seen in two Greek words: schisma & aphorizo
- Schisma—division, split, schisms, & is always used in a negative connotation in N.T.
- Aphorizo-to separate...

- 4. The difference in these two words is the cause of the division or separation.
 Schisms—divisions where self is the issue: me
- Aphorizo—refers to separation where doctrinal truth is the issue.
- 5. Separation (aphorizo) Division (schisma)
- 1. basis of separation is truth
- 2. Unites
- 3. Strengthens
- 4. puts emph. on truth
- 5. guided by Spiritual Love 5. guided by

- 1. individual is basis
- 2. destroys
- 3. weakens
- 4. puts emph. on self

arrogance

- 6. Some passages on aphorizo—separation:
- Matt. 13:49; 25:32; Lk. 6:22; Acts 19:9; 2 Cor. 6:17; & Gal. 2:12—false doc. can cause you to separate from truth. Legalist!
- Now a few passages on schisma—divisions
- GJ 7:43; 9:16; 1 Cor. 11:18 & 1 Cor. 12:25
- With this in mind...Col. 3:14 & Eph. 4:3
- 7. The goal is not unity in & of itself—it is unity in truth & in Spiritual Love led by the Holy Spirit
- (just as politically peace at any cost is not worth the peace)
- If you give up Spiritual truth for unity—you lose---spiritually

- 8. The Goal of local church is the glorification of Christ, not the I-c itself or P-T nor it's members...
- 9. The reason for most schisms in I-c is linked to ignorance of truth, & or occupation with self, & wrongful goals...
- 10. Schisms start in the mind...this is place of battle.
- 11. Schisms are characterized by ego factions
 —coming up in 1 Cor. 1. Emph. on Legalism---self, what I do or don't do.
- Emph. on charasmatics...me! & my speaking in tongues.
- Emph. on praise & worship---self—me---how I feel

- 12. Schisms usually emph. the application of certain doctrines but not the doctrines themselves. Again, making self the issue! Stop judging others!
- 13. Schisms usually threatens the inner coherence of the local assembly & therefore inter-fears with others growth in Scripture & the witness of the local church in the community, or its outreach for Christ.

- 14. The Real problem with Schism is not so much in what they say about themselves but how they attack others in the assembly.
- (Ann Frank Museum in Amsterdam)
- In local church when a group starts criticizing others in the assembly—this is when the danger arises from Schisms
- 15. Solution to Schisms—Spiritual Love in Holy Spirit, thoughtfulness of others...their growth in the Word; & growth of the whole assembly in the Word of God & spreading of the gospel of Jesus Christ.
