Verse 4 Rise of The Chaldean Empire

4"The first *was* like a lion and had the wings of an eagle. | kept looking until its wings were plucked, and it was lifted up from the ground and made to stand on two feet like a man; a human mind also was given to it. Chaldean-warriors –Nabopolasser—united the 5 tribes then he turned against Nineveh.

His son—Nebuchadnezzar (606-605 bc) taking Daniel to Babylon.

Then from Nebuchadnezzar down, rulers were weaker than the one before

Evil Merdoc—Nebuchadnezzar – Nabonidus – Belshazzer.

The lion is a combination of power and speed (some have power,

Some have speed), but a **LION**—combines both—King of Beast

The **lion** has great power in its mouth—its jaws, its teeth.

You will recall that the Anti-Christ in the Tribulation will have a mouth like a **lion**! Powerful mouth—it's jaws and teeth will soon conquer the world to set up it's one world government.

The Chaldean Empire — one of the great empires of all time,

1st in Time of Gentile

With wings of an eagle swift fighters –swoops and hits and kills; (Ezekiel 17:3) When you combine power and speed of a lion with the swiftness of an eagle you have why the Chaldean Empire rose so quickly and became the first empire of time of the Gentiles. What is interesting is that today, in the British Museum one can see the winged lions carved in stone that once guarded Babylon. This is seen in Isaiah 8:8

Wings were plucked Introduces the decline and fall of the Babylonian Empire. Two things happened:

1st Military broke down by weakness, pleasure, prosperity; and arrogance.

2nd Dismantling of the empire....economic disasters loss of wealth by economic arrogance

It was lifted up from the ground...a picture of the restoration of Nebuchadnezzar

Man's heart was given to it restoration by the gospel and by advance doctrine given to Nebuchadnezzar

⁵And behold, another beast, a second one, resembling a bear. And it was raised up on one side, and three ribs *were* in its mouth between its teeth;

We are concerned with world history from **God's** perspective, not **man's** perspective.

God views world history from the standpoint of the Jews.

And if we understand history from God's perspective

then the three ribs represent the first 3 heads of the Seven Headed Dragon.

The **Bear** represents the **Medo-Persian Empire**.

Think about The Egyptian Empire...They were the first empire to impact the

history of the Jews. And this was prophesied to Abraham in the Abrahamic Covenant.

Genesis 15:13 God said to Abram, "Know for certain that your

descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, where

they will be enslaved and oppressed four hundred years.

Israel was under the bondage of Egypt for 400 years. If we understand history from God's perspective Egypt was the first Gentile world power in history to enslave the Jews. Egypt was the first head of the Seven Headed Dragon.

So here is the first rib in the mouth of the Persian Bear.

Now, next in history of Israel,

what world power swooped down and took away the ten northern tribes of Israel? The Assyrians!

So the second rib in the mouth of Persia is the great **Assyrian Empire**, the Second Head of the Seven Headed Dragon. So the first and Second Empires of the world directly affected Israel.

Then who defeated this great Assyrian Empire? Babylon!

And what did this third great empire do in regards to Israel?

<u>Under Nebuchadnezzar</u> they invaded Judah, three times, finally destroying the temple and the city itself, taking into slavery Jews they did not kill.

So we have the three great ribs inside the ferocious mouth of the Bear.

Egypt, Assyria and Babylon.



Properly understanding history: **past**, **present** and **future** requires an understanding of history from God's perspective. And understanding history from God's perspective is **UNDERSTANDING THE HISTORY OF THE JEWS...past**, **present** and **future**.

Egypt, Assyria, Babylon, and Medo-Persian Empires.

The Seven Headed Dragon begins with **Egypt**.

The <u>History of Israel in Daniel</u> begins not with Egypt but with **Babylon**.

Why?

What has changed in Israel?

- **1** Since leaving Egypt in the Great Exodus, Israel has remained in the Promised land.
- **2** Then Shekinah Glory departed from the Temple. Ezekiel 8-11
- **3** Under Babylon's rule the Jews are taken out of the land, and their temple and the city of Jerusalem is destroyed.
- **4** From this point on, all the way to Second Advent of JESUS CHRIST will be theTimes of the Gentiles, where Israel will be under the rule of a Gentile power.

Luke 21:24 and they will fall by the edge of the sword, and will be led captive into all the nations; and Jerusalem will be trampled underfoot by the Gentiles <u>until the times of the</u> <u>Gentiles are fulfilled</u>.

And the Times of the Gentiles will not be fulfilled

until end of the Tribulation.

5 Even during the period of Incarnation of JESUS CHRIST, Israel was under the rule of Rome...the 4th –Terrible Beast of Daniel 7

6 Another interesting phenomenon in the Times of the Gentiles is the Spreading of the gospel and teaching of the Word of God.

These things will be done by Gentiles as well as by Jews.

This started with the Salvation track of Nebuchadnezzar in Daniel 4 and the spreading of the gospel in the Church-Age; part of the Times of the Gentiles is fundamentally accomplished by Gentile Christians.

In the Tribulation this will be primarily done by 144,000 Jews spreading the gospel around the world.

Part of the sign of the coming of the Messiah and the Kingdom was when they became a nation of their own which took place in May of 1948.

Daniel 7:5 And behold [as if the lion were not enough to give Daniel a lot to think about] and behold, another beast, a second one [different from the first] resembling a bear

Remember, that to the Jew, the two most vicious and frightening animals the Jew would encounter throughout his life were the **lion** and the **bear**.

In 1 Samuel 17 while explaining to Saul how he could take on the giant (Goliath), David relayed how he had encountered and killed both the **lion** and the **bear**.

The **lion** and the **bear** —man eating beast— are used to symbolize mankind, in the way man treats man.

The next empire will be represented by a beast like a Leopard -

Greek Empire under Alexander the Great.

Alexander the Great – Short lived Empire [some 12 years] but vitally important to the Jews right up to this day!

Alexander never believed in JESUS CHRIST—unlike **Nebuchadnezzar** or **Darius** or **Cyrus** — here God uses an unbeliever

God uses unbelievers and God uses believers

[unprepared believers prepared believers]

6"After this | kept looking, and behold, another one,

[another beast coming out of the sea of Gentile world.]

like a leopard, which had on its back four wings of a bird; the beast also had four heads, and dominion was given to it.—

What does all this mean?

After this [after seeing the ferocious bear, Daniel kept looking in his vision and] behold [introduces the fact that this was not the end of his vision...] behold another one! [this one] like a leopard.

Which had on its back four wings of a bird

Leopard: SPEED – indicating the fact of history that this empire will secure world dominance quicker than any other empire in history. Under Alexander, he will conquer the known world with a speed like army in 11 years.

Leopard – speed – speed in moving

Four wings:

1 st Wing:	Asia minor—battle of Granticus
2 nd wing:	Tyre, Syria and Palestine
3 rd wing:	Medo-Persian Empire Darius III runs and is defeated by Alexander at the Battle of Arbela—near old Nineveh but runs and is killed by his own men. So the lopsided bear destroyed
4 th wing:	to Babylon – Hemalians Northern Indiathrough the Hindu Cush

All this accomplished in 11 years. Quick like a LEOPARD

Alexander never lost a battle and was wounded some 24 times.

Alexander drank every night...murdered some of his own men in personal conflict,

and anger. Finally his army had battle fatigue and wanted to go home to Macedonia

Alexander went to Babylon--and did nothing but drink and wanted to build a United Nations to form a one world government under his control: <u>but he got sick</u>... and was dying and army came by one by one 18,000 men came by and saluted him then he died. When asked to whom he was leaving his empire,

Alexander replied "to the strongest"

And this brings us to the four heads

Alexander lasted just 12 years.

Koine Greek in which the New Testament was written was designed by Alexander.

Belshazzer died in Babylon;

Alexander died in Babylon one month before he would have turned age 33.

-June 323 bc-

the beast also had four heads and dominion was given to it

Four of Alexander's generals

became rulers of different areas of the Alexanderian Empire.

1 st head:	one is most brilliant –surviving general
	Seleucus –todays Syria; but it was empire from India to Middle East— Seleucid dynasty
2 nd head:	Ptolemy —Egypt. Lasted the longestuntil Cleopatra
3 rd head:	Lysimachus—modern day Turkey
4 th head:	Cassander – Macedon but did not last 4 years
