- Something that SL would recognizes in others
- 1. the ability or inability to be able to grasp/understand bible truth
- 2. The truth that in itself is Divine & beyond human ability to comprehend, it is Divine truth.
- 3. Beyond even how to properly respond to these truths.
- 4. Ability or inability to receive this truth

## Shall give

- This word is used in a technical way here, for God the Father giving every believer of Church Age the Indwelling of the Holy Spirit.
- Indwelling is a technical word for the permanent dwelling of HS inside of every bel. throughout the C-A; you can never lose the Indwelling of the Holy Spirit.
- 3. Filling of HS, is a technical phrase for our receiving the empowerment & fruit & leading of HS when we walk by faith.
- 4. Bel.s in OT were filled by HS but not Indwelt by the HS; they could lose the filling of the HS

- 5. But in the Church Age we are Indwelt by the HS & cannot lose the Indwelling of the HS but we can lose the Filling of the HS. We lose the Filling of the HS by making a decision not to walk by faith in HS...then we sin...& all we have to do to get back into the light or back into the filling of the Holy Spirit is to resume what we stopped doing,
- walking by faith.
- Not by anything we do: confession, sorrow, repentance, etc. just walking by faith.

- 6. So this word in John 14:16 is technical word for the Indwelling of the Holy Spirit.
- Gal. 3:5 Does He God the Father then, who provides/supplies you with the Spirit here provides, in GJ 14 gives
- Who provides you with the Spirit even working ptc power not miracles but power—dunamis in you not among you but in you
- do it by the works of the Law, works required by Law
- or by hearing with faith?

## Problem

- 1. All who believe in Jesus Christ as Savior, are delivered/saved from the Penalty of Sin. Delivered from the Law; delivered from Satan. They are delivered into Eternal-Life; the perfect Righteousness of God.
- 2. But as long as they/we are physically alive here on earth we come under the Power of Sin.
   & we cannot del. ourselves from power of sin by anything we do.
- 3. We are under the power of our flesh nature. & there is no way that we can come out from under our flesh nature. All that we can do is live under the power & influence of the flesh, & maybe try to control it!

- 4. Since there is nothing that we can do, Jesus Christ, out of His love, sent to us another deliverer – another just like Himself. Another deliverer, just as He delivered us from Penalty of sin as unbel.s He sent another just like Himself, to deliver us from the power of sin as believers.
- & both will be by faith!
- as you have rec. Him walk

- 5. Another deliverer to deliver us from /Power of sin. Another deliverer to deliver us from /power of flesh. Another deliverer to deliver us from the power of Satan. Another deliverer to deliver us from the power of the world.
- 6. Jesus Christ sent us another deliverer to deliver us into the light; deliver us into righteousness; into Divine Power; deliver us into love – into the fruit of Holy Spirit.
- Into life! Into fellowship with God.
- 7. & just as we trusted in the first deliverer, we trust the second deliever. Just as we followed the first, we follow the 2en. In /same manner: faith

- The Holy Spirit is God, Deity,
- 1. That He is Deity, God, equal with the Father
   & with the Son. Holy Spirit is God
- 2. That He is Deity is evident by His having Divine Attributes:
- 1. Eternity Heb. 9:14
- 2. Omniscience 1 Cor. 2:10-11; GJ 14:26;
- 3. Omnipotence Luke 1:35
- 3. Works of Deity are ascribed to Him:
- 1. Creation Psa. 104:30; Job 33:4
- 2. Regeneration John 3:5
- 3. Inspiration of Scriptures 2 Peter 1:21

- 4. Raising the dead Rom. 8:11
- 5. Associated with the other two members of Godhead:
- Matt. 28:19; 2 Cor. 13:14; 1 Cor. 12:4-6
- 6. He is referred to as God Acts 5:3-4; 2 Cor. 3:17-18
- 4. Holy Spirit is God, which means that Holy Spirit is not some *power* that we get hold of—why is this so popular? Because this kind of thinking emphasis self again, & exalts self. But the Holy Spirit is God, personal God, with whom we can have fellowship –by faith

- 5. To grasp the concept that a member of the Godhead Indwells me, & by my faith in Him, God acts in my life...pours His love, His joy, His peace etc. in me...and uses me this is most humbling, & most do not want an humbling position. Therefore they come up with all kinds of substitutes for completely depending on HS, like they had to completely depend on Jesus Christ...which is why many refuse to believe in Jesus Christ for Sal. by faith alone!
- & why so many reject Filling of the Holy Spirit by faith alone!
- 6. Many reject our total dependence on HS because they desire to be a part of spiritual dynamics...they love, they love God, Christ; they can learn doc. & apply it...they do not need to rely on HS by faith for the power of a Spiritual life.

- Jesus Christ is our paraklete in heaven
- 1. Christ is our Advocate 1 Jn. 2:1-2 Satan is accusing bel.s day & night, & Christ is our defense attorney. Not that we are innocent, but that it is paid for on the cross Case closed!
- 2. Christ makes intercession for us Heb.

- 3. Christ is the authority of our prayers...pray in His name GJ 14:13
- 4. Christ is preparing our eternal dwelling place GJ 14:2

- Holy Spirit is our paraklete on earth, during our life as bels.
- 1. He is our paraklete in giving us power to live Spiritual life: Eph. 3:16
- 2. He is our paraklete in life & in prayer Rom. 8:26; Eph.6:18
- 3. He is our paraklete—deliverer from the power of Sin: Rom. 7:24 & all of chpt. 8
