- <u>that</u> they may all be one; even as Thou, Father, art in Me & I in Thee, <u>that</u> they also may be in Us;
- <u>that</u> the world may believe that Thou didst send Me.

• That the world may believe that Thou didst send Me.

What kind of Unity?

- Not Organizational Unity
- Not Conformity

17 sanctify them
v 20 I do not ask for these alone...
but for all who believe in me
I ask that you sanctify them all...

- 21. <u>that</u> they may all be one; <u>even as</u> Thou, Father, art in Me & I in Thee,
- <u>that</u> they also may be in Us;
- <u>that</u> the world may believe that Thou didst send Me.

- 1. The oneness of bel.s (union) is vital to Jesus Christ, & He started movement to this request of the oneness, by Sanctification in v 11 where He petitions the Father to keep them in thy name...<u>that</u> they may be one even as we are one
- 2. Then He moves to v 17 where He asked the Father to do something that will keep them in His name: that is Jesus Christ as God the Father to sanctify them.
- 3. Their being one; all bel.s of C-A being one is a result of our being sanctified.
- 4. When we are sanctified, we are placed in Christ & in God the Father.
- 5. Their being one is a result of being in God the Father & in Jesus Christ.

- 6. Unity that Christ is praying for is a sole result of being in the Father & being in Christ. If you understand this, you will understand that there is nothing that we can do to establish this unity.
- 7. Our unity rest completely on our being in Christ & in the Father, not on anything that we do individually or cooperatively. It cannot be enforced by man or by man making this happen. This happens by our being sanctified in Christ & in God the Father the moment we believe in JC.

We become one when we are sanctified by the Holy Spirit in Christ & in the Father

1. 1st lets note distinction between 20 & 21; In 20 believe in me; while in 21 believe that thou didst me

2. simply stated: GJ 3:16 then we point out that this Jesus is the one sent by God the Father to save them! GJ 3:16 is God's message to mankind & it is our message to mankind! This is what we desire that the world know about Jesus Christ—That He is theone sent by God the Father & that through Him, all may come to the Father & have life of God, life eternal

3. One may believe that Jesus was sent by God, but not believe in Him as their Savior. That is not believe in the reason why God sent JC.

- What is it that the world sees that they will know that God the Father sent Jesus Christ?
- 1. How do we know that the Father & Jesus Christ are one?
- By the words of God the Father & by the life of Jesus Christ: the works of Jesus Christ; He came as being sent by the Father; all He says is only what the Father would have Him say; all He does is only what the Father would have Him say. Jesus the Christ brings man to God the Father by all He says & does.
- So how do we, bel.s, bring mankind to Jesus Christ, how do we cause the world to know about Jesus Christ?
- 3. Jesus Himself tells us of two things:

- 1st The Message, v 8 by proclaiming the Word of God-the Gospel;
- Declare, Save, Proclaim This characterized the 3 yrs of public ministry of Jesus Christ & of the early apostles.
- 2nd By our lives Spiritual Love GJ 13:34-35; This love is a fruit that the world cannot produce nor will see except in one who is walking in power of Holy Spirit; the Holy Spirit gives a life with the love of Jesus Christ & a message that God loves the world & sent His son to save. The gospel that proclaims that God loves them & desires them to come to Him.

- Christ revealed is our purpose here on earth.
- Witness for Christ: not a witness for some denomination or some church, not some man, not self, we are not here to be a witness of how wonderful we are, I am! Our lives & our message should glorify Jesus Christ, witness of Christ causes people to be focused on Him who is He? He is sent of God; to do what? Draw all back to God—How? By simple believing in Him! That He is sent of God to die on cross, to bear judgment of sins & be their personal Savior.

- Close with two powerful passages:
- 2 Cor. 5:18-21 & 1 John 1:1-3
