

- we have peace with God...through our Lord Jesus Christ
- we have obtained our introduction ...in the grace in which we stand;
- we also exult; in our tribulations
- poured out within our hearts...
- through Holy Spirit given to us
- while we were helpless,
- God demonstrated His love toward us...Jesus Christ died for us
- we shall be saved
- we were sinners ...we were reconciled;
we shall be saved
- we exult in God...through our Lord Jesus Christ
- Through whom we have received reconciliation

- 1. You have to make distinction between committing personal sins & possessing a genetically natural sin nature. (NSN)
- 2. **Where** this sin nature comes from & **why** & **where** personal sins originate, that is why we sin personally.
- 3. You must understand **what** happens just because we have a sin nature & **what** happens when we commit personal sins
- 4. **Why** am I a sinner the moment I am born, long before I ever commit a personal sin?

- 5. Then you will be able to grasp **why** Jesus Christ, & **what** happens when one believes in Jesus Christ, & **why** you cannot lose your Sal.
- 6. You will grasp the importance of Adam & his relationship to Jesus Christ.
- 7. You will have to grasp the difference between the first birth, our physical birth & the second birth—our spiritual birth.

- Questions:
- Who was this one man?
- What is sin referred to?
- What does it mean: *into the world?*

- Sin can refer to one of three classifications:
 - 1. Adam's original sin in the garden
 - 2. The genetically form propensity to sin; that is: natural sin nature (NSN)
 - 3. Personal sins:
 - sins of the mind: arrogance, pride, hatred, jealousy, anger etc
 - sins of the tongue: gossip, judging, maligning, lying etc.
 - overt sins: murder, stealing etc.

- 1 Adam did not commit the original sin, the 1st sin on earth in the garden.
- 2. But with Adam's sin, which was a personal sin, and with *his* personal sin came the origin of natural sin nature.
- 3. As the father of the human race –that sin nature, natural tendency to sin, was passed down to every member of the human race from Adam & Eve on, everyone born of man & woman.
- 4. The affect of being born with this sin nature is that we are all born, under sin.

- 5. Sin brings about death, spiritual death, so we are all born under sin & we are born spiritually dead.
- 6. We do not possess a sin nature when or because we commit a personal sin; **we commit personal sins, because we possess a sin nature.**
- 7. We are not condemned by God because we commit a personal sin, but because we are born with a sin nature & we are born spiritually dead.

- *the sin entered into the world*
- 1st this is not talking about Adam's original sin—sin entered into the world when Eve sinned. So this is not talking about
- 2. This is talking about the natural tendency to sin (NSN) which came into being, in Adam & is passed on to every human being on earth.
- 3. As to why not Eve? This is answered in 1 Tim.

- 1. Sin was in existence in the angelic realm long before Adam, but sin entered the restored planet earth through the acts of Adam & Eve to stop trusting God. Adam is not the first sinner, Eve is not the first sinner, Satan holds that claim to sinful shame.
- 2. But God did something phenomenal & beyond our thinking. He did not impute Adam's original sin to Adam. In fact throughout human history God has never imputed someone's personal sin/s to that person.
- 3. What God did was to gather every personal sin & put them on Jesus Christ & judged them on the cross.

- 4. What did happen on earth at the time of Adam's Original Sin was that the nature to sin, the genetical propensity to sin, the desire to sin was formed in Adam and was then passed on to every human being after Adam. And as we will see this is the grace of God.

- 5. Every personal sin, throughout all history was judged by Jesus Christ on the cross. Therefore, the judgment for all sins is taken care of on the cross. We are all forgiven on the cross. Sins no longer are an issue between God & mankind. The only issue is Faith, Faith in Jesus Christ as Savior. You don't need to ask for forgiveness of sins—you are forgiven, every unbeliever's sins are forgiven, no unbeliever will stand at the Great White Throne for their personal sins, & personal sins will not be brought up. They were all poured out on Christ on the cross. So, the only reason an unbeliever is even at the Last Judgment is for refusing to believe in Jesus Christ as Savior.
