- \Box Δικαιοσ dikaios is the Greek word for just
- \Box Δικαιοω dikaioo is the Greek word for justifier
- Greek verbs that end in 'oo' generally brings out that which a person is, or that which is desired but not referring to the mode in which this takes place. Here with *dikaioo* it means to bring out the fact that —that person is righteous. So this word means to pronounce one as Righteous. The justifier: to make one or to see that one is Righteous.

- K. Wuest:
- "It was a just, as well as a merciful act for God to save a sinner, for mercy was bestowed upon the basis of justice satisfied. Sin was paid for not condoned.
